Overall Performance of the National Reform Steering Assembly



Background

The duties and responsibilities of the National Reform Council were terminated due to the provision of the Constitution of the Kingdom of Thailand (Interim), B.E. 2557 (2014), section 38 prescribing that National Reform Steering Assembly (NRSA) shall be established in place of the National Reform Council, according to section 39/2, to proceed to instigate reforms in various fields in accordance with section 27 in continuance of work by the National Reform Council. Herewith, consideration shall be given to expediency and achievement of reform in the remaining period of time, and the NRSA's tasks are to study, analyze and propose reform plans and suggestions on reform agendas to the National Legislative Assembly, the Council of Ministers, the National Council for Peace and Order and related agencies. In case an act or an organic bill is required, the National Reform Steering Assembly is obliged to enact the bill or organic bill and submit to the National Legislative Assembly for consideration. Any monetary and financial draft law or draft organic law shall be submitted to the Council of Ministers for further consideration.

According to Rules of Procedure of the National Reform Steering Assembly, B.E. 2558 (2015), NRSA shall constitute its Standing Committees to consider bills, perform any act or study any matter related or assigned by NRSA, in forms of either Standing Committees or Ad Hoc Committees.

The Standing Committees of the National Reform Steering Assembly comprises of 11 Committees which are:

- 1. The National Reform Steering Committee on Political Reform
- 2. The National Reform Steering Committee on Administration of State Affairs Reform
- 3. The National Reform Steering Committee on Law and Justice Reform
- 4. The National Reform Steering Committee on Local Administration Reform
- 5. The National Reform Steering Committee on Education Reform

- 6. The National Reform Steering Committee on Economics Reform
- 7. The National Reform Steering Committee on Energy Reform
- 8. The National Reform Steering Committee on Public Health and Environment Reform
- 9. The National Reform Steering Committee on Mass Communication Reform
- 10. The National Reform Steering Committee on Social Reform
- 11. The National Reform Steering Committee on Sports, Arts, Cultures, Religions, Virtue and Ethics Reform

Each Standing Committee's tasks are to study, analyze and propose reform plans and the timing, provide suggestions in each reform agenda, as well as implement other assignments designated by the National Reform Steering Assembly. Three Ad Hoc Committees of NRSA are also set up which are (1) The National Reform Steering Ad Hoc Committee on Parliamentary Affairs (2) The National Reform Steering Ad Hoc Committee on Prevention and Suppression of Corruption and Misconduct Reform and (3) The National Reform Steering Ad Hoc Committee on Road Safety

Currently the term of the National Reform Steering Assembly is terminated due to the provision of the Constitution of the Kingdom of Thailand, B.E. 2560 (2017), section 266 and delivered its works to the Prime Minister on Monday $31^{\rm st}$ June 2017.


