On 14 October 2019, at Belgrade, Republic of Serbia, the Thai Parliamentary Delegation comprising Hon. Mrs. Pikulkeaw Krairiksh and Hon. Mr. Anusart Suwanmongkol, Senators, Hon. Mr. Sarawut Phetpanomporn, Hon. Ms. Nateepat Kulsetthasith and Hon. Mr. Santi Kiranand , Members of the House of Representatives attended the meeting of Standing Committee on Democracy and Human Rights and considered the draft resolution on “Achieving Universal Health Coverage by 2030 : the role of parliaments in ensuring the right to health”.
