On Tuesday 6th September 2020 at 12.50 hrs., at Press room, 1st Floor, Parliament Building, Hon. Ms. Pacharin Sumsiripong, Spokesperson for the Committee on Children, Youth, Women, Older Persons, Person with Disabilities, Ethnic Groups and LGBTs Division made a statement due to the violence against children by teacher and the babysitting teacher in school that the Committee has continued to follow up and includ this topic in the agenda of the next meeting on 21 October 2020. The Committee planned to invite the representatives from concerning department, for the discussion as follows;

- 1. The Ministry of Education on the issue of the defensive and remedial measures for abused children
- 2. The Ministry of Social Development and Human Security on issues of children and youth protection and remedial measures
- 3. The Ministry of Public Health on issues of physical and mental health for child abuse and the other students who were in the event
- 4. The Royal Thai Police on the issue of using force of laws related to children and youth protection

Furthermore, the Committee will closely monitor the work progress of all related agencies and to cooperate among others for finding corrective remedial measures to prevent such incidents happened to children and youth in the future.
