

The Spokesperson of the Committee on Considering the Draft Constitution of the Kingdom of Thailand Amendment (No. ..) Buddhist Era... (amendment section 256 and add up section 15/1) made a statement

On Thursday 3rd December 2020, at 13.15 hrs., at Press Room, 1st Floor, Parliament Building, Hon. Mr. Somkid Chueakong, Spokesperson of the Committee on Considering the Draft Constitution of the Kingdom of Thailand Amendment (No. ..) Buddhist Era... (amendment section 256 and add up section 15/1) made a statement on the progress of the committee's consideration process. The committee invited Mr. Jon Ungphakorn, representative of the Internet Law Reform Dialogue (iLaw), and Prof. Udom Rat-amarit, the former committee on the Constitution Drafting to attend the meeting and provide the information for committee's consideration on the constitution amendments that will end up today (3 December 2020) at 16.30 hrs. However, at 10.30 hrs., there were 95 members of the Parliament to amend, comprising 87 members of the House of Representatives and 8 senators, the secretariat of the committee, then, will invite the amenders to clarify to the committee further.
