On Thursday 17th December 2020, at 12.15 hrs., at Press Room, 1st Floor, Parliament Building, Hon. Mr. Somkiat Thanomsin, Spokesperson of the Committee on Communications, Telecommunications, and Digital Economy and Society, made a statement on the result of the meeting on the System Development of the National Digital Identity Platform (Digital ID). Nowadays, the digital technologies has progressed increasingly, but, in aspect of government services, where should be developed by using the digital technologies to facilitate the services of required information for public sector in particular. It would be more convenience, responsiveness and accuracy as well as saving time for the operation between public sectors and government agencies on business transactions. However, there were some constraints of the government agencies integration and unready to service. Especially, the Authentication and the Digital Identity Proofing System do not cover all government agencies, including rules and regulations do not support the digital transactions to be lawful. Therefore, the committee will push forward these issues and will collect problems, obstacles and solutions for improving the concrete usage of the Digital Identity Proofing and Authentication System.
