A Press Conference for the Results of Joint Meeting between President of the National Assembly and Representatives of the Tripartite Whips

On Tuesday 24th November 2020, at 11.20 hrs., at the President of the National Assembly Meeting Room, 3rd floor, Parliament Building, H.E. Mr. Chuan Leekpai, President of the National Assembly and the Speaker of the House of Representatives, Professor Pornpetch Wichitcholchai, President of the Senate, and Hon. Mr. Wirach Ratanasate, Chairperson of the Coordinating Committee of the House of Representatives (Government Whip), Hon. Mr. Sutin Klungsang, Chairman of the Opposition Joint Party Coordinating Committee (Opposition whip) and Hon. Mr. Vichien Chavalit, Member of the House of Representatives joined a press conference on the results of joint meeting between the President of the National Assembly and representatives of the tripartite whip, the meeting pass a resolution to make an appointment for the next joint sittings of the National Assembly on Tuesday 1st December 2020. The meeting will consider the matter, that have been approved by the committee on Reorganization of Ministry, Sub-Ministry, and Department Bill (No.....), B.E., then, will consider the Referendum Bill and the motion proposed by Mr. Paiboon Nititawan, Member of the House of Representatives, respectively. Besides, the meeting agreed to cancel the House meeting on Wednesday 9, 2020, since the government announced the official holidays on 10 - 11 December 2020 and scheduled a meeting on Friday 18 December 2020 instead.

Concerning the Reconciliation Commission structure, the Secretariat of the House of Representatives draws the Commission's composition to be a 21 member-commissioners which consists of 2 representatives of government, 2 members of the House of Representatives (government whip), 2 members of the House of Representatives (opposition whip), 2 Senators, 2 representatives of protesters, 2 representatives who have other perspectives, and 9 eminent persons. As for the person who will be the Chairperson, it depends on the consideration of the commission. Mr. Kunawut Tantrakul, Deputy Secretary-General of the House of Representatives, will perform as the Commission's Secretary and, will be the coordinator to all parties. However, there is no need to wait for one half of its members appointment, as well as, to have the commission quorum of meeting if all parties are ready to meet and work for the country problems remedy so as to drive the country step forward swiftly.
