On Monday 1<sup>st</sup> March 2021, at 13.30 hrs., at meeting room, no. 419, 4<sup>th</sup> floor, Parliament Building, Hon. Mr. Terdpong Chaiyanan, Chairperson of the Reconciliation Committee chaired the 7<sup>th</sup> meeting to consider the following issues:

- 1. The statistics and cases of the political gatherings, the meeting agreed to focus on statistics and cases in the current situation and also proposed reconciliation guidelines, to which proceed currently as immediately, there are;
- 1) A peaceful reconciliation process, the peaceful political gathering, assembled under the legal framework and compliances as well as no violence among all parties, is the right under the Constitution;
- 2) Accommodation for fair and justice concerning any political gatherings, such as, the dialogue to find out the resolution regarding the cases on the political-motivated act, which was not real crimes;
- 3) The forum arrangement of discussion for related groups in time, such as, students, college students, and mass media.

2. The public communication and hearing the opinions of the committee guidelines on Monday 1<sup>st</sup> March 2021, from 16.30-18.30 hrs., the Reconciliation Committee would meet and converse with representatives from six media organizations, comprising of the National Press Council of Thailand, the News Broadcasting Council of Thailand, Online News Providers Association, Thai Journalists Association, Thai Broadcast Journalists Association, Nation Union of Journalists, Thailand and field reporters from various agencies at Thai Journalists Association. In this regard, the Committee would accumulate the suggestions from mass media representatives for perusal in the reconciliation built-up process in the future.
