

President of the National Assembly, chaired the tripartite whips meeting

On Monday 12 July 2021, at 10.30 hrs., at meeting room of the President of the National Assembly, 3rd floor, Parliament Building, H.E. Mr. Chuan Leekpai, President of the National Assembly, chaired the tripartite whips meeting. On this occasion, Professor Pornpetch Wichitcholchai, President of the Senate, Hon. Mr. Suchart Tancharoen, First Deputy Speaker of the House of Representatives, Hon. Mr. Wirach Ratanasate, Chairperson of the Coordinating Committee of the House of Representatives (government whip), Hon. Mr. Sutin Klungsang, Chairperson of the Opposition Parties Coordinating Committee (opposition whip), Mr. Maharnnop Dejvitak, Advisor to the Ad-hoc Committee on Senate Affairs (senate whip), Member of the House of Representatives, Senators, political working group of President of the National Assembly, Secretary-General, the executives of the Secretariat of the House of Representatives, and the representatives from the Secretariat of the Cabinet, also attended the meeting for the discussion concerning the arrangement for parliamentary meeting according to regulations of the Centre for the Administration of the Situation due to the Outbreak of the Communicable Disease Coronavirus (COVID-19) (CDC). The meeting resolved to suspend the House's meeting for two weeks during 12-25 July 2021, due to Section 9 of the Emergency Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situations B.E. 2548 (2005) (No.27) of COVID-19 situation. Then, the meeting would resume on 29 and 30 July 2021 after the pandemic situation had been estimated at suitable intervals. The House requested the Secretariat of the House of Representatives to decrease the number of the officers working at the office down to 20 percent in total and 80 percent work from home (WFH), that aimed to reduce area congestion and prevent the pandemic of the coronavirus 2019 disease (COVID-19).
