The 20th Session of the 25th House of Representatives,

3rd Year (Second Annual Ordinary Session)



On 23rd December 2021, at the House of Representatives Chamber, Parliament Building, H.E. Mr. Chuan Leekpai, Speaker of the House of Representatives chaired the 20th Session of the 25th House of Representatives, 3rd Year (Second Annual Ordinary Session) with H.E. Mr. Suchart Tancharoen, First Deputy Speaker of the House of Representatives, and H.E. Mr. Supachai Phosu, Second Deputy Speaker of the House of Representatives, also served as the chair of the sitting in rotation.

The sitting considered the urgent motions, continued from the 20th Session of the 25th House of Representatives, 3rd Year (Second Annual Ordinary Session) on 16th December 2021 as follows:

1. The request for the House of Representatives to establish the Ad-hoc Committee on the study of the impact of the merger of telecommunications companies, True Corporation Public Company Limited and Total Access Communication Public Company Limited; 2. The request for the House of Representatives to establish the Ad-hoc Committee on the study of the impact on the people from the merger of telecommunications and retail, as well as the impact of the large capital expansion affecting the small villagers' capital in order to find measures to protect the people, consumers and villagers' capital;

3. The request for the House of Representatives to establish the Ad-hoc Committee on the study of the impact on the people from the merger of two telecommunications businesses companies, namely True and DTAC, which may affect the people;

4. The request for the House of Representatives to establish the Ad-hoc Committee on the study of the impact on the people in case of the merger of telecommunications and retailwholesale businesses in order to find urgent measures for protection of the people;

5. The request for the House of Representatives to establish the Ad-hoc Committee for the study of the impact on the people and consumers in case of the merger of the telecommunications companies between True Corporation Public Company Limited and Telenor Group or DTAC;

6. The request for the House of Representatives to establish the Ad-hoc Committee on the study of the impact on the people from the merger of telecommunications, retails and the expansion of large capital affecting the small capital in order to find the measures for protection of consumers and small capital;

7. The request for the House of Representatives to establish the Ad-hoc Committee on the study of the impact on the people in case of the merger of two telecommunications businesses, namely True and DTAC, to reduce the monopolization in telecommunications business networks;

8. The request for the House of Representatives to study such impact in case of the merger of mobile operators between Ture Corporation Public Company Limited and Total Access Communication Public Company Limited;

9. The request for the House of Representatives to establish the Ad-hoc Committee on the study of the impact on the people from the merger of telecommunications and retail businesses, as well as the impact of large capital expansion affecting small villagers' capital to find the measures for protection of the people and local capital. The sitting resolved to establish the Ad-hoc Committee consisted of 25 members for further considerations and the time limit for amendment to those motions was set for 90 days.
