

The 27<sup>th</sup> Session of the Third Year of the 25<sup>th</sup> House of Representatives  
(Second Annual Ordinary Session)



On February 2, 2022, Mr. Chuan Leekpai, Speaker of the House of Representatives, presided over the 27<sup>th</sup> session of the third year of the 25<sup>th</sup> House of Representatives (Second Annual Ordinary Session), in the House Chamber with Mr. Suchart Tancharoen, First Deputy Speaker of the House of Representatives, and Mr. Supachai Phosu, Second Deputy Speaker of the House of Representatives, serving as Chair of the meeting in rotation.

**Matters that the Committee has considered**

1. Draft Road Traffic Act (No. ...) B.E. ...

The meeting approved the bill and concurred with the observations of the Committee, which will be forwarded to the Cabinet.

**Urgent matters**

1. The Draft Act on the Prevention of Recidivism of sexual and violent offenses proposed by the Council of Ministers.

2. The Draft Act on Prevention of Repeated Offenses of Violent Offenders B.E. ... proposed by Ms. Patcharin Samsiripong et al.

The meeting resolved to approve the principles of both proposals concurrently and to form an extraordinary committee to review them, with a major focus on the Cabinet's draft law. Any amendments may be made within 7 days.

3. The Senate's proposal to amend the Kratom Plant Act B.E. ...

The meeting disagreed with the amendment and appointed a member of the House of Representatives for joint consideration.

4. The Senate's proposal to amend the Animal Husbandry Profession Act B.E. ...

The meeting rejected the amendment and appointed a member of the House of Representatives for joint consideration.

5. The Senate's proposal to amend the Witness Protection Act in Criminal Cases, B.E. ...

The meeting rejected the amendment and appointed a member of the House of Representatives for joint consideration.

### **Pending matters**

1. The Draft Labor Protection Act (No. ..) B.E. ... proposed by Mr. Anutin Charnvirakul et al.

The meeting resolved to approve in principle of the bill and to set up an ad-hoc committee to consider. Any proposed amendment may be made within 15 days.

2. The Draft Military Court Constitution (No. ..) B.E. ... proposed by Mr. Wanmuhamad Nor Mata et al.

The Council of Ministers requested that the aforementioned bill be given further consideration before the Parliament gives its approval in principle.

3. The Draft Excise Tax Act (No. ..) B.E. ...

The Council of Ministers requested that the aforementioned bill be given further consideration before the Parliament gives its approval in principle.
